

Guidelines to Qualify for State-Sponsored Event Designation

(Color Guard Credit for Bronze Color Guard Medal Awarded at the State Level)

- Event is advertised state-wide, inviting chapter presidents or their representatives and all state society compatriots. Color guard members from throughout the state would be invited, with good representation expected. Color guard would perform by posting the colors as part of the ceremony.
- Event is of state-wide interest, such as a Revolutionary War monument dedication. Local grave markings would not normally qualify, as that event may not be of statewide significance.
- Event normally includes the State Society President or his representative who either presides or gives the main address. This would include Board of Managers meetings and state conventions.
- To obtain one-year's credit for participation to qualify for the State Bronze Color Guard Medal, a color guard member must perform in at least half of the state-sponsored events for the year, for a three year period. Years don't have to be consecutive.
- It is the responsibility of each color guard member to keep his own records and to apply to the state color guard commander when he has qualified for the award of the medal.
